STARS AND STRIPES FLOATING IN ARKANSAS. Price Drive from Missouri—Gen. Curtis in Hot Pursuit—Official Dispatch. The following dispatch was sent from head quarters to night:

ST. LOUIS Feb. 18. (S. M. P. Press.) The Union is going in Arkansas. 'General Curtis has driven Price from Missouri, and is several miles across the Arkansas line, cutting up Gen. Price's rear and hourly capturing prisoners and stores.

Fortress Monroe, Feb. 11.—By a flag of truce to day, we have news of the complete success of the Burnside Expedition at Roanoke Island. The island was taken possession of, and Commodore Lynch's fleet of steamers completely destroyed.

Elizabeth City was attacked on Sunday, and evacuated by the inhabitants. It was previously buried, whether by our shells or by the inhabitants is not known for certain.

The first news of the defeat arrived at Norfolk on Sunday afternoon, and caused a great excitement. The rebel force on the island was supposed to be only a little over three thousand efficient fighting men.

The rebel fortifications were supported by a small naval force, under Commodore W. E. Lynch. The names of the rebel steam gunboats were the 'Isis', (captured from the Union), 'Curtis', 'Sea Bird' and 'East Boy'. Each of these vessels had an armament of two guns.
