The following despatch from General Burnside to General Halleck was received at 9 o'clock this evening: HEADQUARTERS ARMY OF THE POTOMAC, Dec. 10—6 P. M.

The army of the Potomac was withdrawn to this side of the Rappahannock river, because I felt fully convinced that the position in front could not be carried and it was a military necessity either to attack the enemy or retire.

The army was withdrawn at night without the knowledge of the enemy, and without loss, either of property or men.
