The deceased was a distinguished physician and most estimable man whose sudden demise casts a shade of gloom over a very large circle of friends, not only in the immediate neighborhood of his late residence, but throughout the State.

U. S. 10-40 Bonds.

The interest on this debt for the coming fiscal year will be \$4,507,125, while the customs revenue in gold for the current fiscal year, ending June 30th, 1864, has been so far at the rate of over \$100,000,000 per annum.

It will be recalled even the present gold revenues of the Government are largely in excess of the wants of the Treasury for the payment of gold interest, while the annual receipts from customs on the same amount of importations, to \$150,000,000 per annum.
