

ARRIVAL OF THE ASIA.

Three Days Later from Europe. By the Asia, we have our European Correspondence, and London and Liverpool files to the 3d instant.

The British Parliament had adjourned. The debate on the motion of Mr. Whiteide, for a vote of censure against the government for the fall of Kara, was passed to a division, but the motion was lost, the majority against it being 127.

The official proceeding of the Peace Congress, just published, proves that the most interesting feature happened after the treaty was signed, in interchange of sentiment upon various subjects of European interest.

The interchange of opinions was invited by Count Walewski, who, among other things, referred to the disturbed state of Italy, recommending that suggestions for a milder title be conveyed to the Italian governments, in which suggestions the plenipotentiaries heartily agreed.

Count Cavour, on behalf of Sardinia demanded that a secular government be established in the Roman Legations, and that the Austrian troops be withdrawn.

Sharp words ensued the Austrian and Sardinian Representatives, but it ended in nothing.

The Confederation then proceeded to the discussion of the new declaration of maritime law, in reference to neutrals, &c., and to all the principles of this law the Plenipotentiaries gave their adhesion.

Letters from Rome state that the Ecclesiastical circles were panic struck at the Sardinian programme of Italian reform.

A letter from Berlin says that the proposal of England to capitalize the Sound Dues is not acceptable to Denmark.

THE LATEST. [By Telegraph from London.] LONDON, Saturday morning, May 3.—The treaty between England, France and Austria, guaranteeing the independence and integrity of the Turkish empire, was presented in Parliament yesterday.

Lord Clarendon's dispatch in answer to Secretary Marcy's note of the 28th of December, was laid before Parliament last evening. The Daily News, in its comments upon the matter, refers to the demand for Mr. Cramp's recall, as an invitation for the English cabinet to disgrace itself for the amusement of the Government at Washington.

London, Friday evening, May 2.—The funds showed a heaviness this morning, and at one time the extreme decline was \$1. Prices rallied, however, and closed at \$1 1/4 lower than the highest sales of Wednesday.

Business was languid on the Stock Exchange, excepting for French shares, which advanced in sympathy with the upward movement at Paris.

Protection to the Panama Route.—We learn from the official correspondence of the Panama Railroad Co., that the English and French consuls have united with our own in sending for men-of-war on both sides of the Isthmus of Panama, to protect passengers and property from any recurrence of outrage on the part of the inhabitants.

Chicago Land Sales.—Fifty lots in Chicago, Illinois, which cost \$9000 three years ago, were sold last week for \$27,000; and the Fair Ground property, which was recently sold for \$4000 per acre, was purchased eight years ago for \$100 per acre—just one-fourth of that sum!

The Recognition of Padre Vigil. WASHINGTON, May 15.—Yesterday afternoon Secretary Marcy sent for M. Marceleta, the resident Minister from Nicaragua, as an act of courtesy, and informed him of the determination of the administration to receive the Padre Vigil as the Minister from the new government of Nicaragua.

Our Native Wines.—The Ohio Valley Farmer estimates, from statistics of the Horticultural Society, that there are two thousand acres of Catawba vines in cultivation in the vicinity of Cincinnati, of which 1600 acres are in full bearing.

The new patent law proposed in Congress will allow all patents which have not expired for twenty years to be extended for that length of time from their first issue. It will not expire at the end of their term, all patents under the old law, which have run through their first term of fourteen years, and now have the seven years' extension.
