TRUTH IS MIGHTY, & MUST PREVAIL. Report of the Committee appointed to superintend the burning of the Iron Safes at Reading, Feb. 27th, 1857.

The undersigned, members of the Committee, do respectfully report, that we saw the two Safes originally opened upon by Farrell & Herring and Evans & Watson, placed side by side in a furnace...

The fire was started at 8 o'clock, A. M., and kept up until four o'clock of green hickory, two cords of oak and half chestnut top wood were entirely consumed...
