REPORTING AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth...

ARTICLE XI.

OF PUBLIC DEBTS.

Section 1. The State may contract debts...

Section 2.

In addition to the above limited power the State may contract debt to repel invasion...

Section 3.

Except the debts above specified, no debt shall be contracted...

Section 4.

To provide for the payment of the present debt...

Section 5.

The credit of the Commonwealth shall not in any manner...

Section 6.

The Commonwealth shall not assume the debt of any other...

Section 7.

The Legislature shall not authorize any county...

Section 8.

In the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four...

Section 9.

At the end of section seven, same article, insert these words...

Section 10.

The legislature shall have power to alter, revoke, or amend...

Resolved, That this resolution pass on the first amendment...
