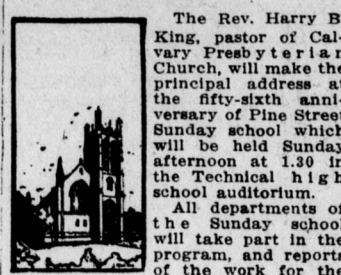

For the first time in the history of the Dauphin County License Court the license league will be represented at the annual session to-morrow.

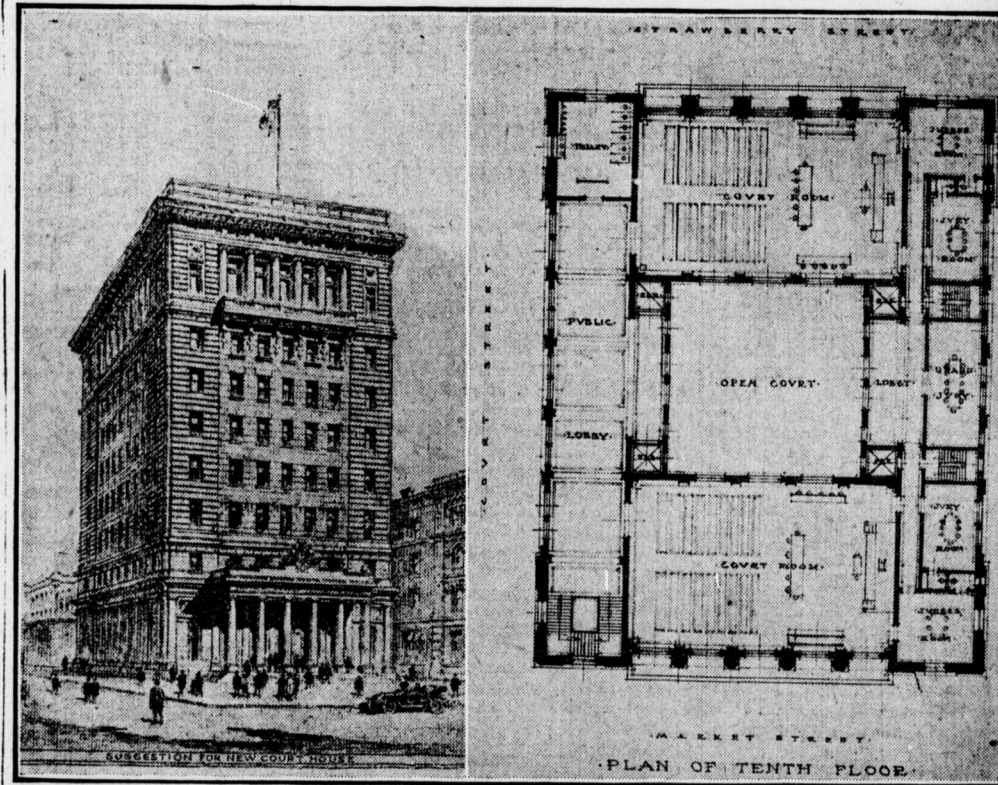
