BENTON INCIDENT DEPRESSED MARKET

Foreign Selling Was Influential in Shaping Course of Market; Low Priced Stock Unloaded

By Associated Press. New York, Feb. 28. - Apprehensions of grave developments in the Mexican situation, as a result of the Benton incident, depressed the stock market early in the week. Foreign selling also was influential in shaping the course of the market.

Uncertainty over the Mexican situation abated and foreign liquidation apparently was completed. The market made up the losses of the forepart of the week.
