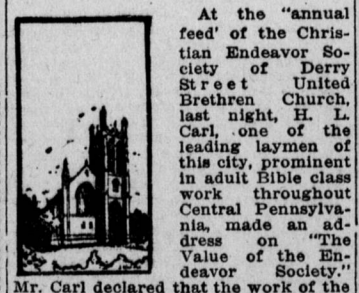

### ENDEAVOR WORK OF GREAT IMPORTANCE

H. L. Carl Tells Derry Street Young People Society Is Training Ground For Bigger Things



At the "annual feed" of the Christian Endeavor Society of Derry Street United Brethren Church, last night, H. L. Carl, one of the leading laymen of this city, prominent in adult Bible class work throughout Central Pennsylvania, made an address on "The Value of the Endeavor Society." Mr. Carl declared that the work of the Endeavor society in the church is even more productive of good results than is the adult Bible class. "For years," said Mr. Carl, "I firmly believed that the adult Bible class work was the most important of all the activities of the church. Now, however, I am certain that more men and women are brought into the church through the work of the Christian Endeavor Society than through any other organization. "No young man can afford," said Mr. Carl in closing, "to miss the development that the Christian Endeavor will give him. The C. E. society is the training school for the workers of the morrow." The social of last evening was the most elaborate in the history of the Derry street society. The feature of a musical program was an original skit written by a member of the society and staged by a dozen of the younger boys and girls, called "An Hour of Study." Speakers who followed the luncheon of the evening included E. F. Weaver, Frank Manly, president; Roland Kenn and Mr. Carl.

Chairman of the committee in charge of the arrangements was Miss Miriam O. Carl.
