BETTER SHOWING IS MADE IN MARKETS

Railroad Stocks Responded With General Advance; Morning Rise Sante a Point

By Associated Press

New York, March 20. - Liquidation in low-priced railroad stocks, which has held the market in check recently, was suspended to-day. Rock Island securities, in particular, made a better showing. The effect on the general list of this improvement was heightened by intimations from Washington that the administration favored an increase in freight rates for the Eastern roads.

Central feature of the day was a general advance, and ultimately the industrialists joined in the movement, although held back for a time by sluggishness of United States Steel, which was affected by further reports of slackening of business in the steel industry. The morning rise ran to a point or more in many cases.
