New York, April 2. — Confident operations on the long side of the market were resumed to-day, after an early period of hesitation. The ready response of the market to increased buying confirmed assertions of bullish traders that no considerable demand could be satisfied except at higher prices, owing to the meager floating supply of stocks. Hope of an early adjustment of the railroad rate problem was the predominating influence.

The general rise ran up to a point in various instances, with larger gains among the specialties. A few stocks were heavy. Baltimore and Ohio sagged two points. Buying slackened toward noon,
