The names of George W. Leisman, Harry F. Gilman, Harry F. Ceasey, Albert M. Hamer and Samuel H. Garland and Mr. Lynch added Townsend's name, for the assis-

ant city assessorship.
The Commissioner of Finance moved for an election and Messrs. Bowman, Lynch and Taylor voted for Mr. Townsend while Mayor Royal and Mr. Gorgas turned in for Leisman. The Mayor before voting let out his usual wall about the violation of the spirit if not the letter of the Clark commission form of government act in that polltax was being used in naming the candidates. He told a story of how one of the candidates had had the promise of three of the commissioners to vote for him, but that the candidate in question had been called into the office of E. E. Beitelman and

there promised the printing of the "constitutional amendments," if he would withdraw his name. Leisman, according to the Mayor, refused.
Mayor Royal was the only speaker. William F. Hurley, George W. Straw and Daniel H. Heisey were nominated by Mr. Gorgas for the special tax officer's job and to this Mr. Bowman added the name of Mr. Block. Messrs. Bowman, Lynch and Taylor voted for Block and Mayor Royal and Commissioner Gorgas were lined up and voted for George Straw.
Appoint Planners
The appointment of Ed. S. Herman, George W. Reily, Benjamin F. Un-

berger, George A. Shreiner and Francis Jordan Hall to be Harrisburg's first city planning commission, was made without demur from the Mayor. The vote was unanimous.
When Mr. Gorgas' name was called he smiled.
"Well, here's where I vote the straight ticket," said he.
New legislation introduced included an ordinance by Mr. Taylor authorizing the purchase of a plot of ground in Derry street, adjoining the Melrose school, to be used for a firehouse for the Royal fire company, cost not to exceed \$1,300; by Mr. Taylor ap-

propriating \$50 to be used for Memorial day exercises. By Mr. Bowman, ordinance transferring \$260 from the filter plant fund to the salary of the assistant bacteriologist.
