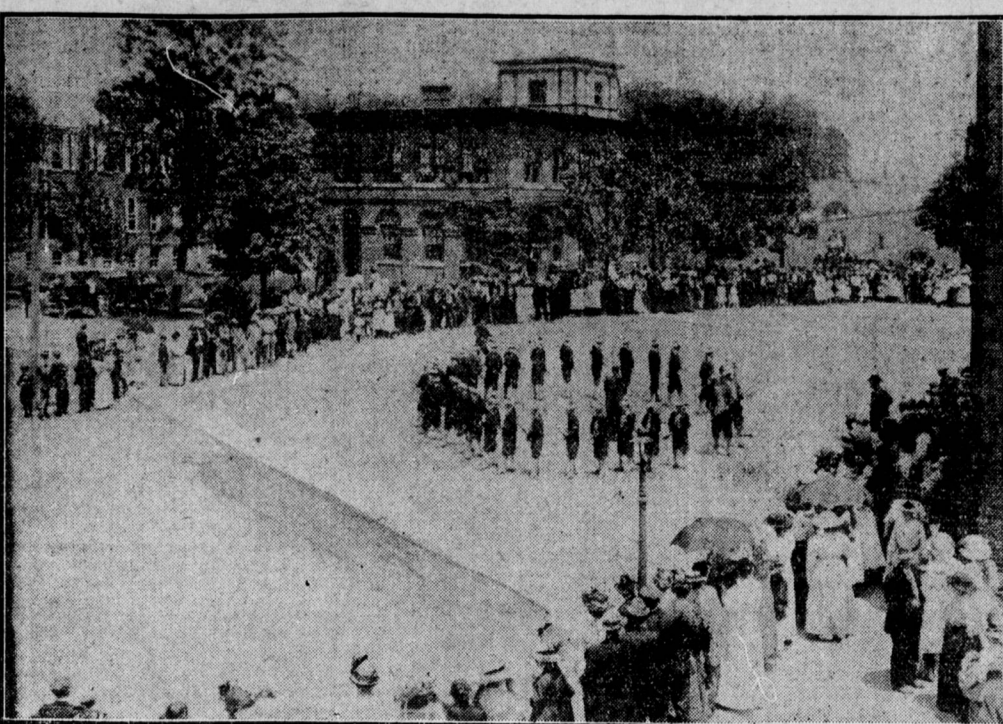

to the wings, for which contract has already been let, and agreement of the additional work will be done within a few weeks between the contractor and the government.

Mr. Kreider's Foresight Congressman Kreider late last winter, after an inspection of the building, and setting aside \$125,000 for the improvement of the pass and consultation with Postmaster Frank C. Sites, found that the structure as contemplated under the Olmsted improvements would not be sufficiently large to accommodate the postal traffic now passing through the local office, much less take care of its growth in the future.

Unanimous Consent When the measure came up for final passage a special emergency bill which required the unanimous consent of the members, Congressman Kreider took the floor and in a brief but convincing speech impressed upon his fellow-congressmen that it would be a matter of economy to appropriate at once the money for which he asked in order that the work at Harrisburg, which would have to be done eventually at all events, could all be done under one contract.
