St. Paul's Decline Due to Lowery of Public to Subscribe New Bonds

New York, June 11. - A decline in St. Paul, from which there was but slight recovery, was ascribed to disappointment in financial circles over the failure of the new bonds to be more readily absorbed. This was regarded as indicating an unsatisfactory investment situation. The movement all through the morning session was extremely apathetic, with some buying on recessions. Tobacco specialties were inclined to drop. Such discussion as bore upon the market dealt almost entirely with the freight rate situation now before the Inter-state Commerce Commission, which it was authoritatively declared, is sure to be announced by the end of the month.
