WILSON POLICY MAY INCREASE MARINES

Demand For Complement of Men For Haitian Service Exhausts Corps

Washington, July 23.—With twenty-five full regiments of marines now on expeditionary work, in addition to the many men of the same service scattered throughout the Philippines and Guam and elsewhere, the marine corps is having difficulty in meeting the demands made upon it for a full fledged army to carry out the policies of the Administration in regard to Haiti and San Domingo.

At the funeral of a distinguished American admiral held yesterday it was found impossible to turn out a single marine, although there were several hundred marines in the barracks in Washington.

Corps Under-officered

In addition to the shortage of marines the marine corps is reported at present to be greatly under-officered; in fact, with less than half the number of officers to attend the regular army maneuvers.
