The meeting, the climax of a day's vigorous campaigning, was the largest ever held in Towanda. H. S. Putnam, superintendent of schools in Bradford county, presided. Five hundred persons filled the largest room in the courthouse with 200 more unable to gain admission waiting patiently to catch a few words of the speeches. To accommodate these an overflow meeting was held. The candidates after finishing their addresses in the main room delivered a talk in the second.
