CACTUS DERBY PUT CARS TO SEVERE TEST

Paige Maps Out New Route For Famous Los Angeles; Phoenix Road Race

The eyes of the motoring public will turn westward November 9 when the Los Angeles-Phoenix road race, known as the Cactus Derby, will be run. This will be the seventh annual start of the Pacific Coast Classic, and

run. This will be the seventh annual start of the Pacific Coast Classic, and the victorious driver who pilots his car successfully through desert sands and up and down the preciptous mountain trails will be crowned "Master Driver of the World." In addition to the title he will receive a purse of \$5,000, a silver cup and other awards.

The route selected will be entirely different from any hitherto used. Some time ago Leon T. Shettler, chairman of the racing committee of the Western Automobile Association, mapped out a new route using a Paige "36" as a pathfinder. The Paige behaved so satisfactorily in this trying work that two others have been entered as regular contestants for the 1914 Cactus Derby honors.

The new route, which will be covered in three days and is 691 miles long, is north of any hitherto used. It runs from Los Angeles to San Bernardino, thence over the Santa Fe, Grand Canyon, Needles National Highway to Ash Fork, Arizona, thence south through Prescott to Phoenix. The first night control is at Needles just west of the Colorado river and the second night control is at Prescott.




