Dillsburg, Pa., Jan. 9.—A men's Bible class was organized in the Lutheran Sunday school last Sunday with over fifty members.

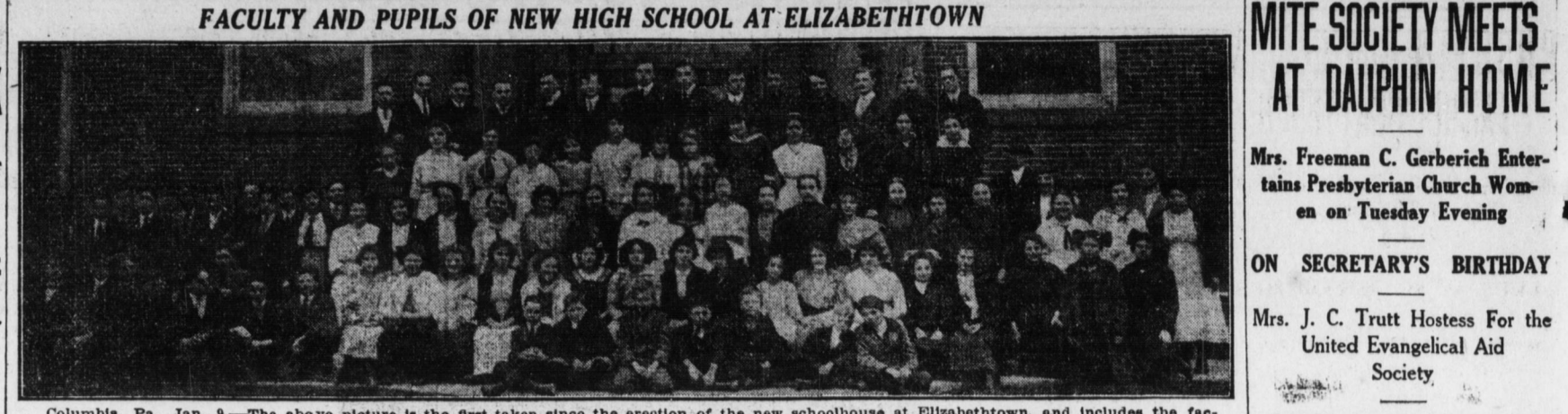
