STOCKS SHOW GAINS

AT MARKET OPENING

Mexican Petroleum Was Feature of Special Groups With Advantages of More Than Two Points

New York, Jan. 25. - Stocks showed general gains at the outset of today's session and the undertone was distinctly firm. Changes were very minimal there and trading was moderate. Mexican Petroleum was the feature of the special group with an advance of over two points. Coppers advanced in response to the higher price for the metal.
