

By Associated Press Chicago, Jan. 27.—Squads of men began disinfecting the Chicago Union Stock yards to-day for the second time within three months to prevent a pos-sible serious outbreak of foot and mouth disease. Orders received by Dr. U. C. Houck, chief veterinary inspector of the Fed-eral Bureau of Animal Industry, plac-ing an embargo at the yards against the shipment of cattle out of the yards until the miles of pens and al-leys have been disinfected, beacuse af-fective yesterday. The order was is-sued because it was suspected that a new case of the disease found among cattle originated at the Chicago yards.
