The entire clubhouse will be turned over to the banqueters. The rooms are decorated in black and gold, with jonquills forming the centerpiece.

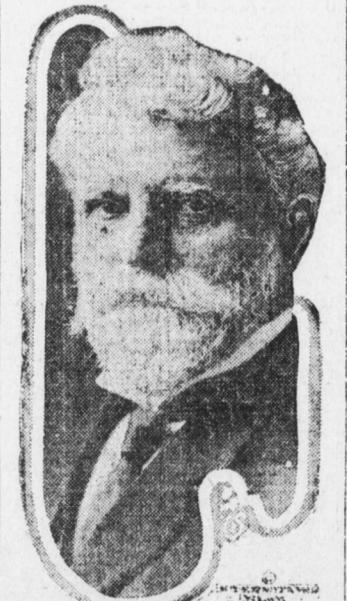

\$200,000 Given For Engineering Research

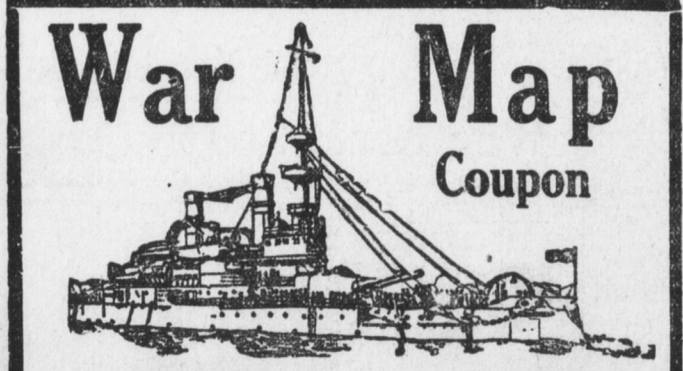
