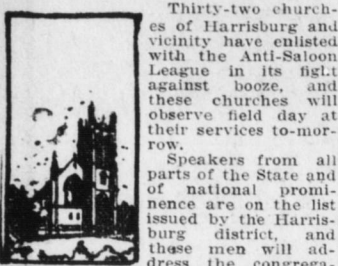


BIG MEN TO SPEAK AGAINST BOOZE HERE

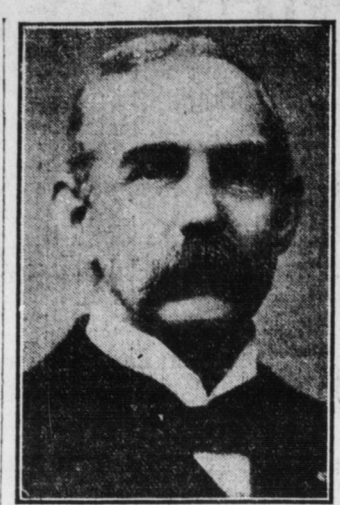
