London, March 2, 12.10 P. M.—Operations or the French and British fleets against the Turkish fortifications on the Dardanelles, which during the past week had taken the warships of the allies some fifteen miles through this well defended and narrow waterway, are at a standstill to-day on account of a gale of wind accompanie by a heavy mist which hinders the efficient marksmanship of the naving unners necessary to reduce the second line of forts concealed by the hills. This respite is likely to prove of benefit to the Turks but the allies, realizing the necessity of pushing any Oriental offensive movement with energy, will resume the attack as soon as possible.
