LAW DEPARTMENT

Attorney General Presents His Ideas in Two Well Drawn Bills For the House

CENTRALIZES MATTERS

House Holds a Busy Evening Session to Clear the Deck For the Week End

Attorney General Brown's bills for eorganization of the State's law department and centralization of the legal business of the Commonwealth were introduced into the House by Mr.

partment and centralization.

legal business of the Commonwealth were introduced into the House by Mr. McNichol, Philadelphia, last night and will be promptly acted upon by the judiciary general committee.

One bill places all legal business and affairs of every branch of the government under "direction and control of the Attorney General," requiring all chiefs of departments or bureaus to report all litigations or difficulties, delinquent taxes or other accounts to the Attorney General, who will look after them, and to follow advice given. No branch of the government may employ counsel for departmental business after passage of the act, but all selections of local or special counsel to handle cases are to be made by the Attorney General, who will designate their compensation. The act will affect most of the departments of the State government now having their own counsel.

The companion bill reorganizes the Attorney General, sl2,000 per year; first deputy, \$7,500; one deputy at \$6,000; two deputies at \$3,500, all to be appointed by the Governor; private secretary, who is also to be a stenographer, \$3,500; three law clerks at \$3,000 each; two deputies at \$3,500, all to be appointed by the Governor; private secretary, who is also to be a stenographer, \$3,500; three law clerks at \$3,000 each; two deputies at \$3,500, and telephone operator at \$900. The Attorney General is authorized to appoint such additional deputies, law clerks and stenographers "as he may deem necessary, whose compensation shall not exceed in the aggregate \$20,000 per annum." All officers and employes are to perform such duties as shall be assigned them by the Attorney General.

Seventy-two bills were reported to the House as the result of activities of committees during the day. In the list of bills reported were those authorizing municipalities to tax real estate of public service corporations, authorizing third class cities to tax realty of railroads, etc.; reducing retail oleo license; for State licensure of barbers; classifying counties as cities are classified; appropriating \$240,320.47 to counties as reimbursement for bounties apid; providing for taxation of life insurance companies without capital stock; second class city automobile taxation bills; requiring posting of primary election returns at polling places; regulating practice of optometry; requiring assessors to supply agricultural statistics to county commissioners; amending the dental laws and regulating sale of chicory.

"I agree in this judgment, and would respectfully ask you and your committee at your next meeting to arrange for a public hearing on the afternoon of April 6, a day which in equity and justice seems to me to be fair; and at this hearing all porties and interests should receive the same fair and impartial opportunity to present what to them seems wise concerning this measure.

"I respectfully request that you grant this hearing on the date above indicated, and beg to be "Respectfully yours, (Signed) "M. G. BRUMBAUGH."
