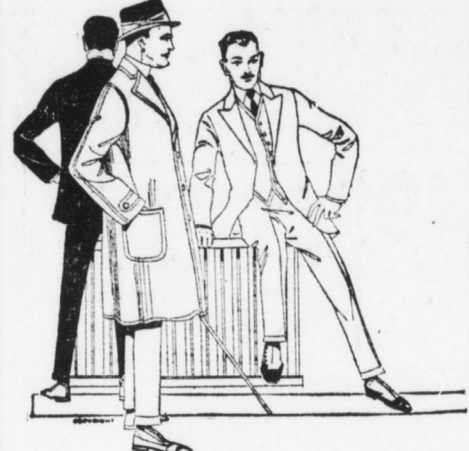
The great growth of the fund illustrates the increase in the number of automobiles in the State and in the manner in which licenses have been put out thus far means anything next year will be about \$2,000,000.
