New York, March 31. — Specialties were again the feature of chief interest during to-day's early trading session of these issues changing hands in blocks of 1,000 or more shares. Motors stocks made the greatest gains, their rise extending from one to 2 1/2 points. National Lead also added two points to its rise of the preceding session and Amalgamated a point. In the railway division activity in Rock Island was resumed, that stock soon advancing to 2 1/2 point above its high price of yesterday. Missouri Pacific, Denver and Rio Grande, Grand Northern Ore and Bethlehem Steel all showed gains of a point or better.
