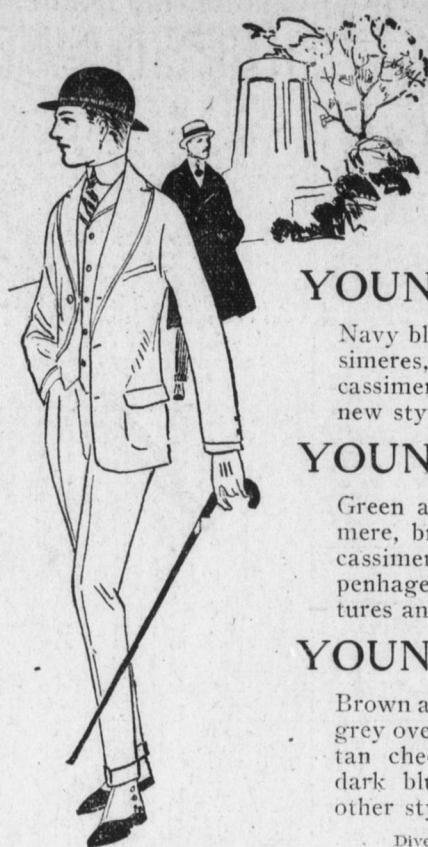

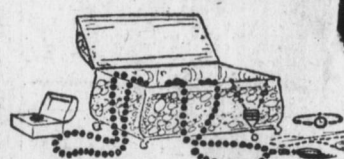

The Elks' memorial monument, the highway which is about fifty-feet wide makes a broad sweeping curve up the slopes and the grade is easy of approach. Hundreds of squares of sodding that had been removed in November for the excavations has been piled to one side and is in excellent shape. This will all be replaced.

Building to within fifteen feet of "Taylor boulevard" as the roadway through the E. B. Mitchell estate tract will be known, will be prohibited by the action of the City Planning Commission. The Mitchell tract is the section that is being developed by the Rev. W. S. Harris and lies just next to the entrance at Market street and is bounded by Whitehall street and the park.
