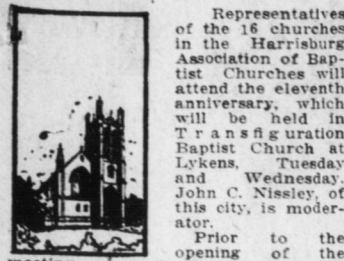


BAPTIST ASSOCIATION TO MEET AT LYKENS
