Quincy, Mass., May 4.—The torpedo-boat destroyer Tucker, launched at the yards of the Fore River Shipbuilding Corporation to-day, is one of the largest ever built for the United States navy. It measures 315 feet over all, with a beam of 29 feet, 10 inches and a depth of 17 feet, seven inches.
