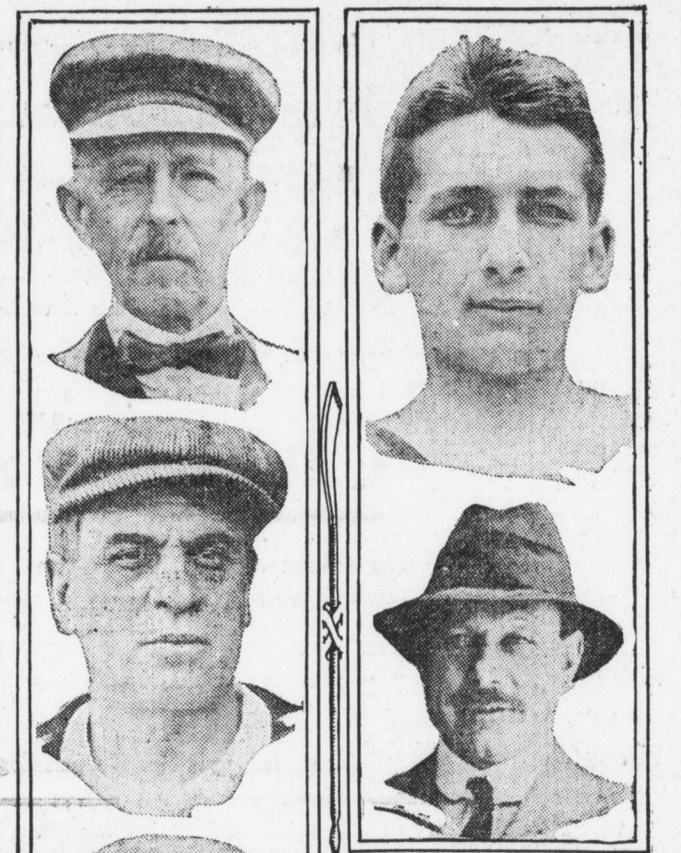
Line-up of Crews in Poughkeepsie Race Today
