PRICES GOING UP THEIR FLUCTUATION

Reading, N. Y. C. and Can. Pac. Among Few That Make Any Headway

By Associated Press New York, June 30. - Wall Street - Prices of stocks were irregularly during the first hour with increased apathy later. Reading, New York Central, General Electric, Westinghouse and Baldwin Locomotive rose 1 to 3 points. Amalgamated Copper, American Smelting and Refining, metal stocks were fairly strong, also Mexican Petroleum. Rubber lost much of its advance, but other active stocks, notably United States Steel, were firm. Further weakness in foreign exchange exercised restraining influence. Bonds were heavy.
