LOS OF AMERICANS TO BE CONSIDERED "UNFRIENDLY ACT"

Washington, July 21.—The United States has decided to inform Germany that further loss of American lives as the result of German submarine warfare in contravention of the principles of international law, will be regarded as an "unfriendly act." The discussion of principles is virtually ended. The American government will now warn Germany of the interpretation it will place on future transgressions of American rights.

VIGOROUS BIDDING IN NEW YORK MARKETS

Bethlehem Steel Touches Price Unequaled by Nondividend Stock

New York, July 21.—Vigorous bidding up of war specialties was renewed at the very outset of to-day's trading, Bethlehem Steel and American Can scoring new high prices at 129 1/2 and 55, respectively. Crucible Steel, Westinghouse and Allis-Chalmers rose 1 to 1 1/2 points and United States Steel advanced 3/4 on a sale of 1,200 shares. These gains were soon extended, Bethlehem Steel touching a price unequalled by a nondividend stock, while Crucible gained over 2 points. Trading was very active, but railway shares, which were lower in London, were again relegated to a comparative obscurity.
