WAR STOCKS SAID TO BE IN GOOD DEMAND

Widest Movement Today was in Bethlehem Steel, Influenced by Merger Report

New York, July 25 - War stocks were in good demand in the early trading to-day and considerably higher prices were established. Aside from the war stock issues the market was uncertain and irregular. The widest movement was in Bethlehem Steel, which was influenced by a report of its proposed new combination of steel companies. Bethlehem Steel rose 8 points over the high record of 26 1/2. Baldwin Locomotive and American Can also made record prices, with the latter stimulated by reports of further merger war orders. In the railroad section Canadian Pacific, Lehigh Valley and St. Paul lost about a point each. Considerable heaviness was also shown by the various copper stocks. In the outside market sales were made of Electric Boat at 410, a rise of 48 points over Saturday's close.
