RUSH IN MARKETS TO BUY WAR SHARES

New York, July 29. - There was a rush today for war stocks at the opening of the market. Credible Steel, Westinghouse Electric and Allis-Chalmers were bought in lots of several thousand shares and these stocks, as well as Bethlehem Steel, reached new high records. Speculation in Credible Steel was particularly vigorous. The opening was 6,000 shares at 85 1/2 compared with yesterday's close of 65 1/2. The price mounted rapidly to 75 1/2, an advance of 10 points on the week. Bethlehem Steel jumped six points to 270. Westinghouse Electric opened with 6,000 shares at 112 1/2. Credible Steel yesterday's close of 110 1/2. Railroad shares were held in check. The price of the dividend action is to be taken to-day, slumped three points.
