"To inspire the teachers of this type we have borrowed an idea fom that year temperance force. The Flying Squadron,' and a similar organization is being formed to go over the entire country to preach the gospel of better schools.

"Vocational schools were organized in Williamstown, Wiconisco and Ly-kens. Most of the courses elected were along the line of practical mining."

"There are 315 teachers in the county. Reports from most of them show that more than 12,000 persons visited the schools during the past year. There are 171 schoolhouses with a total of 325 rooms. The 16 high schools have made notable progress in the way of improved courses, equipment and higher standard of teachers. Millersburg will add a teacher of commercial branches to its high school faculty. The superintendent made a total of 450 visits to the schools under his jurisdiction."
