THE NEW SCHOOL HOUSE The new school building on part of the old circus grounds at Fifth and Mahantongo streets begins a new de-parture in school building in Harris-burg. The building eighty by one hundred and eighty feet, sets on high ground about the center of a plot of nearly three acres. 




