**STANDARD STOCKS**  
**AGAIN AT FRONT**

**Union Pacific Was Prominent Feature, Initial Sales Being at an Advance**

 New York, Aug. 11. — Standard stocks were again to the fore at the opening of to-day's market, yesterday's demand for those issues being resumed. Union Pacific was the prominent feature, its initial sale of 500 shares being made at an advance of 1 1/4 points white St. Paul, Northern Pacific, Atchison and Louisville and Nashville soon rose 1 to 1 1/2. These gains were coincident with word from Washington that a number of foreign rate increases had been granted by the Interstate Commerce Commission.

Minor roads, like Kansas City Southern and Erie also were active and strong. United States Steel was inclined to react after a moderate advance at some of the war specialties, notably Bethlehem Steel and Crucible Steel lost 2 to 3 points.
