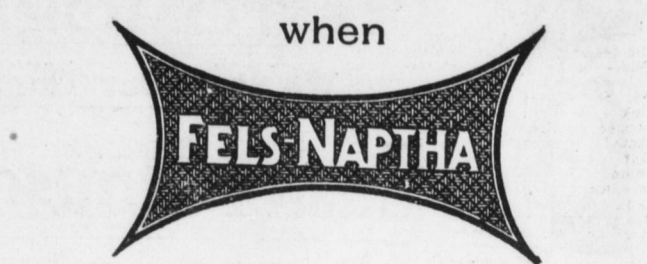
No Trouble to Remove Superfluous Hair
