[Continued From First Page.] things, the world will seek Harrisburg. And the cost is so little that it's really ridiculous. Frank R. Roberson, the world's greatest traveler, whose coming has been awaited with keepest interest,

will arrive to-morrow with his baggage car of equipment and his staff of assistants. (It is no Magic Rug of Euzdad that the traveler travels upon.) And by 8.15 to-morrow evening everything will be in readiness for the remarkable tour of Germany.

**Thousands of Feet of Film** Hundreds of beautifully colored views and thousands of feet of new motion pictures will be used in the screen journey. Berlin and all the large cities and small, out-of-the-way places are to be seen, and then the tour will widen in its scope and sweep out to the trenches along the Teuton-Slavic line of the eastern front where battles which shake all Europe and the world are being fought. The German soldier on the firing line will be

pictured, as well as the German farmer in his fields. Peace and war are to be combined in the most interesting of screen-tours.

The travelogue on Germany has proven so popular everywhere it has been presented that Mr. Roberson will give it twice in opening. It will be the same each evening; the remarkable motion pictures of the kaiser, General von Hindenburg, members of the German general staff and royal family all being shown.

But on Saturday evening comes an entirely new travelogue, "Belgium and Holland," in which the wreck and ruin of war of battle-wrept Belgium will be contrasted with the quiet peace and picturesqueness of quaint old Holland.

Ten cents is all it need cost—that is general admission. If you prefer a seat in the reserved section it is 25 cents. These tickets are on sale in advance daily at the Telegraph office. For them a coupon is not necessary and admission included.
