On the journey east the special train will make many stops in Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Tennessee, Kentucky, Missouri, Illinois, Indiana, Ohlo, New York, New Jersey and in Pennsylvania.

There were so many requests for a view of the bell from New York State that the committee at the last moment changed its itinerary and instead of having the bell come directly east from Pittsburgh the route was changed so that it will go north from Western Pennsylvania to Buffalo, across New York to Albany and then down the Delaware valley to this city, It will arrive in Philadelphia on Thanksgiving Day. There will be a fitting welcome home celebration.

The journey of the bell to and from the Pacific Coast will cost the city of Philadelphia about \$75,000.
