SUNDAY SCHOOL WORKERS MEET IN DERRY ST. U. E. More than 250 teachers and officers of Sunday schools in Harrisburg and vicinity were present last night at the conference of the Dauphin County Sabbath School Association, held in the Derry Street United Brethren Church. Preston G. Orwig, superintendent of the secondary division work of the Pennsylvania State Sabbath school association, spoke on "Methods of Holding and Teaching Boys and Girls." E. F. Weaver, president of the county organization, had charge of the conference. H. B.
