RULE OPENING

Lackawanna's Rise of 5 1/2 Points Chief Feature; War Shares on Decline

New York, Jan. 5. — Higher prices prevailed at to-day's opening, standard shares, specialties and coppers scoring general gains with a few unimportant exceptions. Lackawanna Steel was the chief feature, soon advancing 5 1/2 points to 82 1/2 and Tennessee Copper rose a full point. New York Central again led the railway division, opening at a slight decline but soon advancing sufficiently to reach its quarterly dividend of 1 1/4 per cent. The Pacific and some of the eastern lines also showed fractional advances. United States Steel was in demand, rising well above yesterday's final quotation. New York Albrake led the specialties, advancing 3 1/2 to 149, later increasing this gain.

The market developed a feverish tendency soon after the opening, with abrupt declines in various specialties, particularly the war group. Bethlehem Steel fell 1 1/2 to 44 1/2, United States Steel 5 to 65 and oil and motor issues were 2 to 4 points under. U. S. Steel fell from 88 1/2 to 87 1/2 and rails were similarly affected. The only new issue to account for the break other than the so-called international situation was a rumor that financial institutions were exercising greater discrimination in their acceptance of industrial collateral. Trading was active on the set-back but by midday most losses showed full recovery. Bonds were irregular.
