ACADEMY HIGH

Privilege by West Point

National recognition of the high standard of scholarship which prevails at the Harrisburg Academy has been accorded in a letter which Headmaster Arthur E. Brown has received from the Captain of the Coast Artillery Corps, United States Military Academy, West Point, N. Y., to the effect that the local academy has been granted the certificate privilege. This means that students of the Academy who enter West Point may do so under the certificate method and will be relieved from all except physical examination.

Nothing that has happened of recent years has pleased so much those who are interested in the Academy's welfare. It is considered a very complimentary action which the West Point authorities have taken in this matter and indicates emphatically the high opinion which is held abroad of the quality and thoroughness of the mental training afforded to Harrisburg Academy undergraduates.
