Rider Awarded Nearly Thrice Original Sum in York Haven Case

Following a retrial upon orders of the Supreme court, the trespass action brought by John E. Rider, a lower end farmer against the construction of a dam across the Susquehanna below Middletown, was concluded for the second time by a retrial.

In 1913, the verdict totaled \$6,492. Of this amount \$1,000 was allowed for damages to the crops covering a period of four years and the remaining \$5,492 was given as punitive damages.
