SPEEDY ACTION ON CARNIVAL IS URGED

to extend the scope of the work the personnel will be increased from nine, as originally proposed, to fifteen members. V. Grant Forrer, assistant park superintendent, has written to Warren H. the wall, the majority thought a permanent house would answer best. Other suggestions were for a permanent house to be erected at a central point with one or two floating structures to be moored along the wall in the upper and lower ends of the city. "Hardscrabble" was the better location for the boathouse in the opinion of most of the boatmen; few considered the city's island a satisfactory place.

"Wing Walls" on Dam That the "danger" points along the waterway should be marked by buoys was generally conceded; that a channel from 25 to 50 feet wide should be blasted through the "riffles" in the upper end of the city was also the consensus of opinion.
