BOARD WARNING ON COUNSEL FEES
Important Notice Issued Today by the State Compensation Officials
The Workmen's Compensation Board to-day directed that the following letter be sent to every insurance carrier insuring against workmen's compensation liability within the State:
"It has come to the attention of the

Workmen's Compensation Board that in certain cases where compensation has been paid under agreements or awards to the attorneys of claimants, the attorneys have retained or induced the claimant to pay to them exorbitant fees or unduly large percentages of the instalments paid, without having had their fees approved by the board, as required by Section 501 of the compensation act.
"The board emphatically disapproves of such practice on the part of the attorneys. In order that this may be impossible in the future, the board requests you to pay all compensation due, either under an agreement or an award, direct to the person entitled thereto, even though such person is represented by an attorney of record, unless the attorney shall furnish to

you the board's approval of his claim for legal services and expenses."
DANIEL MORRETT DIES

INSURE LIVES IN FAVOR OF COLLEGE
Princeton Men Plan Unique Way to Raise Alumni Memorial Fund
Princeton, N. J., April 13.—Insuring their lives in favor of their college is the latest means which has been devised by the senior class at

Princeton University for raising an alumni memorial fund. The system has been approved by both the Princeton Graduate Council and the Board of Trustees, and it is expected that after twenty-five years the class will have at least \$60,000 to present to the University.
The insurance policies will be taken out individually by the members of the graduation class, and the premiums will range roughly from \$4 to \$15 per year, bringing in a return of from \$100 to \$400 each. The policies are to be held by a large insurance company and will be divided into three classes, the entire principal being paid to the University after twenty-five years.
This is the first Princeton class to have undertaken this system of rais-

ing funds. Previous classes have organized Memorial Committees and through these committees secured individual contributions each year. In addition to the insurance scheme, the present seniors have also offered to make individual contributions.
OUR PREPAREDNESS IN MEXICO
In rounding up Villa the two factors are speed and eyesight—i. e., transportation and scouting. As regards both these the army is under its usual handicap of administrative and Congressional neglect. The expedition against Pancho's outposts had been a lively possibility for many months before the Columbus outrage forced our action, but in all that time the administration had not come to any practical understanding with the

de facto government. Permission had to be obtained before our troops could start into Mexico, and that permission did not (at first) include the use of the railroads! Our forces went in by foot and horseback, and shipped their supplies by autotruck. Villa had the enormous advantage of a long start, and that advantage was given him by our own government's tardiness. These matters are important because, if the administration is to show strength and brains in foreign affairs, it might as well begin at our own borders, and if Congress is to do anything for the nation's defense it must begin by attending to the essential requirements of our present army and navy. The Mexican middle shows that neither beginning has been made as yet.—Collier's.
