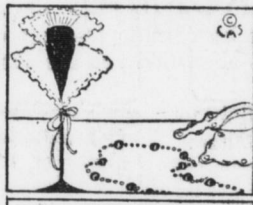

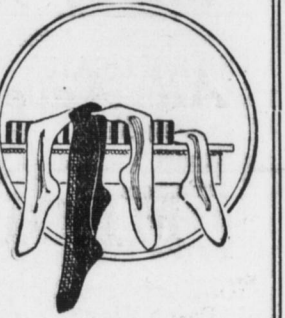
Women Who Wear New Clothes Will Wear New Hosiery

\$1 to Indian School as "Conscience Money"

Carlisle, Pa. — Superintendent O. H. Lipps, of the Carlisle Indian

School has just received a letter containing \$1. It was addressed to the Indian school and the envelope was postmarked Cleveland, Ohio. It read: "Dear Sir—Please find \$1 for articles taken some time ago. Conscience money and oblige former citizen."

An interesting feature is that the bill is a Government silver certificate signed by Gabe Parker, former Controller of the Treasury, himself an Indian. Superintendent Lipps will turn the money over to the conscience fund at Washington.
