HERSHEY NOW HAS CLAIMS OFFICE
MODERN PLANT
Ice Cream Freezing and Hardening Facilities Permit 5,000 Gallons Each Day

Extensive alterations have just been completed at the plant of the Hershey Creamery Company in South Cameron street, whereby it becomes one of the most complete and sanitary ice cream plants in the country.

A new hardening room has been constructed with a capacity of 5,000 gallons per day which the front cream is sent by gravity conveyers.

The most modern type of pasteurizers have been installed, holding 200 gallons each, in which the cream is held for half an hour at a temperature of 145 to 150 degrees, to insure proper pasteurization.

Mr. Hershey says that nearly 700 farmers now bring milk to the various creameries and separator stations owned by the Hershey Creamery Company.

CLAIMS OFFICE WAS "INVADED"
Another Demand Made For Return of Plot Papers Taken With German

New York, April 20.—Another demand for the return of the papers seized in the office of Wolf von Igel, under indictment in the alleged German plot to destroy the Welland canal, was made to-day upon Federal District Attorney Marshall by John B. Stanchfield, the defendant's attorney.

The district attorney said Mr. Stanchfield had maintained that Von Igel's office (formerly that of Captain von Pape, recalled German military attache) was in effect German territory and that the intrusion of United States agents constituted an "invasion."

Mr. Marshall said that he replied that the matter rested for decision with the Washington authorities; meantime he had no alternative but to proceed with the case.

The documents seized by Federal authorities, return of which has been demanded by Count von Bernstorff, the German ambassador, remain to-day in a safe in the office of the United States district attorney.

Persons who have seen the papers say they do not believe Count von Bernstorff admits that any are official records. The papers are described as constituting "the largest haul made by the government since the operations of a Teutonic spy system in America will be revealed, including the names of the alleged directors of plots to destroy commerce and of men who obtained secret information for that purpose.

RIOTERS JABBED WITH BAYONETS

N. Y. Militia Drives Mob Back; Woman Attacks Troopers

Hastings-on-Hudson, N. Y., April 20.—With four companies of State militia in control to-day of this village the strike situation involving employees of the National Conduit and Cable Company was quiet except for one minor disturbance in which two foreigners attempted unsuccessfully to disarm a trooper.

A dozen men, characterizing this trooper as "a soldier," told him they were about to take away his gun and bayonet. Two rushed forward and the militiaman whacked one on the skull with the gun and thrust his bayonet through the fleshy part of the other's shoulder.

Three men received bayonet wounds. One was removed to a hospital and the other two to the local jail as military prisoners.

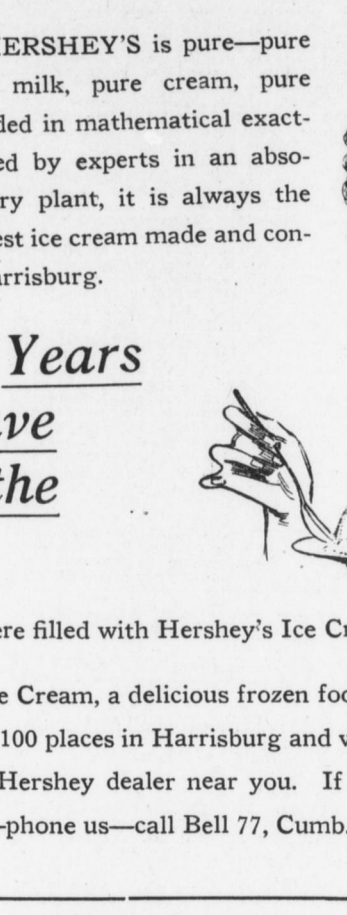
