MILITARY CAMPS DRAW STUDENTS

Academy Boys Show Interest in July Camp at Plattsburg; Ten May Enroll

The Harrisburg Academy may be represented at the Plattsburg Military Training Camp in July this summer is the prospective plans of a dozen or more of the student material. The address of Dr. Henry S. Drinker, president of Lehigh University and chairman of the governing board of the military training camps, before the Academy boys the other morning gave the purposes and possibilities of the Plattsburg training, and suggested the establishment of a camp for boys under eighteen years who cannot qualify for the junior or senior divisions as now in force. Several professors and the following boys professed an interest in and a desire to attend the July camp, which runs from July 5 to August 5: John Ross, a former student at Culver Military Academy; Boyd Rutherford, Chester A. Good, E. S. Herman, Jr., Howard Kreider, James J. Finn, R. G. Stewart, Nathan Stroup, William Walters and John R. Hart.
