Philadelphia, Pa., May 12.—The United States District Court here to-day dismissed the bill of the Lehigh Valley Railroad Company which sought to restrain the Interstate Commerce Commission from enforcing its order divorcing the railroad from its interests in steamship lines on the Great Lakes.

ASQUITH ARRIVES OR CONSULTATIONS

COURT MARTIAL OFFICER

London, May 12.—A Central News dispatch from Dublin says that a court martial is trying to-day the officer believed to have been responsible for the putting to death of P. Sheehy Skeffington, the Irish editor, who is said to have been executed without sanction from military authorities.
